ARTICLE XIV: NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Bylaws to Article XIV: Nominating Committee

The Nominating Committee will consist of the lead pastor as chairman, three elders selected by the Church Leadership Team, and three members-at-large elected at the annual meeting. The term of service will be for three years, with one member-at-large and one elder added each year.

The Nominating Committee will work in consultation with the Church Leadership Team in the nomination of elders, secretary, and treasurer. It will collect input from the Church Leadership Team and the membership. The Nominating Committee will then recommend these individuals to the membership for confirmation. The election of these persons by the membership would be a vote to sustain the preliminary approval of the Church Leadership Team.

In addition, the Nominating Committee will nominate the assistant treasurer, Church Leadership Team liaisons, deacons, trustees, and at-large Nominating Committee members for election at the annual meeting.

The Church Leadership Team shall determine the number of elders, trustees and deacons to be nominated for election based on the needs of the congregation.
