

Lobby Improvement Project

About:

As a congregation, we have voted to undertake a project to renovate our Lobby and East hallway areas. Combined, these areas make up over 6000 sq/ft.

We agreed to a total cost of no more than \$250,000 for this project. Our hope is to raise the funds by the end of 2018. We plan to complete the work in phases as funding is available.

The lobby area is the largest space in our building next to the sanctuary, and is expected to be an inviting and comfortable space. It needs to comfortably accommodate both large events and intimate gatherings. The layout of the area must improve traffic flow, especially on Sunday mornings and for large events.

As we continue to refine the plans for this project, feedback and suggestions are welcomed and even encouraged. We want to ensure we make the best possible use of what the Lord has provided, and our desire is to create a space that is as beautiful and functional, serving our congregation's needs for many years.

What is Included:

The project plan calls for new flooring, new paint, new ceiling, new furnishings, new signage and a more permanent area for serving coffee. A furniture budget has been set and is to include comfortable seating areas and stand-up tables for added convenience.

Design Details:

The design calls for wood-look beams on the ceiling, warmer and more attractive lighting, replacement upgraded ceiling tiles and the addition of a chair rail around the perimeter with fresh paint on everything. The flooring is a commercial grade wood-look vinyl (LVT) for ease of cleaning and long-term durability.

Other items included in the project are updated navigational signage to guide guests, sound proofing of or new sanctuary doors and hardware, a floor scrubber to allow us to keep this much hard flooring clean and even window treatments.
